Footnotes

THE ALCOVA KID tracked the leaders along the inside under light rating to the backstretch, made a steady advance on the first flight through the far turn, took over approaching midstretch and held safe the challenge of KENTUCKY MILE under brisk handling. The latter worked his way to the inside tracking the leaders for a half, swung four wide entering upper stretch to challenge, drew on terms with the pacesetter near midstretch but was outkicked to the wire. HAITIAN, reserved off the inside, angled five deep entering upper stretch to challenge, continued a bit erratically late but just missed the place. POWERFUL PEPPER tracked the leaders off the inside to upper stretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. LASTING FREEDOM stalked just off the pacesetter racing outside a rival to the backstretch, assumed brief command on the far turn but failed to sustain his momentum through the final quarter. CASE IN POINT never seriously menaced. THE CLIFF'S END stalked the pacesetter along the inside in second flight but emptied out after a half. BOLD PARTISAN sped clear of the field racing to the backstretch while attempting to drift out, bolted entering the far turn, then was vanned off the course.
