Footnotes

LADY KNOWN AS LEW stalked the early pace three wide, angled in into the turn and moved up to challenged for the lead into the stretch, gained a clear lead at the three sixteenth pole, drew off through the lane while being kept to the task. SOMERSET BALLERINA tracked the early pace on the rail, was blocked into the stretch, waited, angled out and closed willingly, then ran evenly the final furlong while clearly best of the rest. DANCEHALL ROXIE set the early pace inside, stayed on through the lane to hold the show safe. WINEY CAT mid pack and off the rail, angled in into the turn, moved to a striking position, then angled out to bid four wide into the stretch and got up for a share. LUMPASUGAR second flight and between rivals, moved up on the two path through the turn and gained a striking position, then weakened the final furlong. DESIGNED TO RUN improved position. STEAMIN COCOA well placed and off the rail, looped rivals three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and faded in the drive. STORY TIME FOLLY showed little. PUMA'S PLANET raced wide. BRASS RHAPSODY was a brief factor. BILAN BIORN was never involved.
