DANCINGWITHBIGRON stalked the pace outside, moved up to challenge into the stretch, could not go with the winner, stayed on to be clearly best of the rest. ROCKET WRENCH broke a step slowly, moved up quickly to gain position, came three wide to bid into the stretch and got up for the show while no threat to the top two. R J TISHEBA'S SYN stalked the pace inside and steadily lost ground. MANLEE SPIRIT trailed the field.
