UNCHAIN THE TRAIN well placed and inside, angled out to loop rivals three wide through the turn, took command into the stretch and drew off under steady pressure. SMOKEM GRAY tracked the early pace inside, was blocked into the stretch, angled out to bid three wide, then closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. FRANKS ON FIRE broke a step slowly, angled out to bid three wide, then had a mild gain in the lane. LUCKY LEHMAN stalked the early pace outside, moved up to challenge outside the pace setter, then weakened the final furlong. INDY N MISSION set the early pace inside, faded and was outrun.
