BENOLA, bumped at the start, recovered to track the leaders three wide, made a steady advance to challenge the pacesetter nearing midstretch and drove clear. PARAGRIN sprinted clear of the field along the inside, held sway to midstretch but proved no match. PRINCE RAJ was urged to contend between foes racing into the turn, never gained terms with the top pair and just prevailed for a share. UNLAWFUL DETAINER broke in, bumped BENOLA, was collected off that foe to track outside foes, raced five wide to upper stretch and produced a mild response to improve his placing. GOTTA BELIEVE ME was urged to secure a forward placing in the opening stages, stalked the pacesetter into the bend, then came up empty in the drive. GRANT TOWN BLUES was never a factor. RUSSIAN REPRIEVE chased the leaders along the inside, then quickly retreated in the drive.
