STAKES Minnesota Turf Championship S. - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$35,000 guaranteed (\$21,000 from Canterbury Park and \$10,000 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund), of which \$21,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 117 lbs; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 at one mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2010, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2009-2010, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED (On the Scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2009-2010 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner by Canterbury Park. Nominations closed Thursday, August 19 with 54. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.).

Footnotes

SIR TRICKY vied for the lead through the first turn, was rated back nicely and allowed to settle just off the pace, angled back out to bid three wide into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. MACK'S BLACKHAWK broke sharply to set a moderate pace while pulling, dueled with BEAU NAMED SUE through the lane, shook clear inside the eighth pole and was outfinished. BEAU NAMED SUE moved up quickly three wide, dueled with MACK'S BLACKHAWK to the eight pole and weakened. MINNESOTA MAFIA rated back on the outside, angled in quickly, gained a striking position through the second turn, then lacked the needed late kick. LUVIN' GEORGE was a brief factor.
