LUCKY HIGH vied for the early lead inside, challenged for and gained a short lead into the stretch, then shook clear and lasted under steady pressure. HAVASU mid pack and inside, gained position through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, angled out for clear racing room, then made a steady gain in the lane and missed. SAFE N RICH never far back and off the rail, moved up through the turn, then closed willingly to gain the show while no threat to the top two. SPEAKERS ACTION set the early pace outside, could not go with the winner into the stretch, stayed on and faded the final furlong. MIGHTY TIZZY passed tiring rivals. ALL BETS ARE OFF never far back, looped rivals three wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and faded in the drive. RASIN A DELIGHT well placed and off the rail, gained position through the turn, came three wide to bid and had no rally.
