GREAT RIVER SKIER edged up and took command heading into the far turn and remained clear to the wire. R U JOSHIN ME made a bid between rivals in the far turn and gained position to finish second best. LET DA COWBOY ROCK saved ground racing along the inside in the backstretch, slipped through along the rail in the upper stretch and steadily gained position. CHEAP CHOCOLATE reserved in early stages, swung out five wide in the far turn and improved position in the drive. PRAIRIE APPEAL made a three to four wide bid at the top of the lane and finished evenly in late drive. BOLD RAIDER began to pick up the pace three wide in the far turn and flattened out in the late drive. TENPIN STRIKE raced two to three wide and failed to threaten. DALBO raced two wide in the upper stretch and lacked late response. RUN AWAY INDIAN took command at the start, challenged by eventual winner leaving the backstretch and had nothing left in the far turn.
