COUNCIL OAK set the pace three wide, shook clear through the turn, then drew off in the lane and was ridden out. SCHILLERTHEKILLER tracked the pace on the inside, moved up through the turn on the two path, came three wide to bid and closed willingly through the lane to get up for the place and be clearly best of the rest. AURORIN SHOT vied for the early lead from between rivals, dropped back slightly through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and stayed on to hold the show safe. FRANKIE DAPPER well back, moved up on the two path through the turn, came three wide to bid and passed tiring rivals in the lane. SUGAR STORM never far back, moved up four wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and faded in the drive. CAT FROM ROME stalked the pace on the inside, steadied into the turn and faded. BLADE SCUFLER was no factor. SOME KINDA BOY broke a step slowly and was never involved.
