MACK'S TIGER PAW set all the pace, was challenged down the backstretch, dug in and responded gamely to be well clear in the final stages under a strong hand ride. RAGGED EDGE settled off the early pace, moved up three wide in the stretch and was no match for the winner. SUN COUNTRY pressed the pace along the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. AFFIRMED CURE stalked the pace, saved ground and had no final bid. QUOTE TO CASH was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. C J MAMAS BOY saved ground and never menaced. SUGAR BUSINESS dropped back early and never threatened. VICTORY SLED failed to sustain a bid.
