All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. WEIGHT: 122 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. WINNERS PREFERRED. (Non-starters least preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

SHE CAN SKI pressed a fast pace while racing just off the inside, built a clear lead into the upper stretch and held gamely under strong encouragement. BLUMIN SWEETHEART stalked the pace, moved up three wide and gained ground in the latter stages. BAD RIVER BELLE stalked the pace, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and made a good late gain. ECHO CANYON stalked the pace, raced three deep and weakened a bit in the drive. ROCKIN THE BLEU'S dueled for the lead along the inside and faltered in the drive. CRIMSONEXPECTATION was slow early and never threatened. SASSY PRANCE failed to menace. SUNDANCE showed little.
