All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. WEIGHT: 122 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. WINNERS PREFERRED. (Non-starters least preferred). Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

APPEAL TO THE KING pressed the pace, raced along the inside in the stretch, dug in at the eighth pole and prevailed in a game effort. YOU BE GATOR BAIT stalked the pace, moved up five wide into the lane and finished gamely to just miss. A P IS LOOSE stalked the pace from the outside, raced four through the turn and finished willingly to the wire. ORANGE THUNDER settled off the early pace, saved ground and had no final winning bid. BET YOUR SOCKS was unhurried early, moved up five wide in the stretch and never was a serious threat. VANDERBILT BEACH was slow early and never menaced. HOLY KEONI showed good speed and gave way. HEARTOFDEMI dropped back early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. PURE SURPRIZE failed to sustain a bid. REGARDS was off slowly and remained back throughout. DEMIS TIE was slow early and never menaced. ROYAL TRAMP raced far back and never was involved.
