ORIENTAL TARA reserved along the inside early, advanced steadily to contention on the bend, swung four wide entering upper stretch and produced a sustained rally to wrest command in time. GOLDEN ECHO attended the pace three wide in early stages, pressed in that path into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner but proved best of the others. MAMAMA, forwardly placed along the inside, stalked the leaders to upper stretch and continued willingly for a share. SHOW TOPPER was sent to the lead, dueled for command along the rail to upper stretch and gave way in late stages. JUST J. J. tracked outside foes to the lane but offered no rally. SPARKLING ENDEAVOR was never a factor. JOVIAL ANGEL tracked outside foes in the second flight, was fanned five wide racing into the lane and faded in the drive. STORMING N SEATTLE stumbled at the start and trailed.
