GLITTER STAR stalked just off the leaders to the backstretch, advanced in hand three deep entering the far turn to challenge, took over entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. DYNABIN, allowed to settle in the opening half, angled out three wide nearing upper stretch and closed the gap belatedly. TENS HOLY SPIRIT angled inwards from the break to force the pace outside a rival, dueled between foes into upper stretch and gave way. TURBULENT THINKING sped to the fore along the inside, disputed the pace inside a rival racing to the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. MEADOW SKIPPIN was devoid of early speed, tracked the leaders outside a rival to the far turn but steadily faded from contention. MA HOME CAT tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside to the far turn and never mounted a serious challenge.
