STAKES Minnesota Sprint Championship S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$50,000 guaranteed (\$36,500 from Canterbury Park and \$10,000 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund), of which \$30,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 119 lbs; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 in 2011 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2011, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2010-2011, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED (On the Scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2010-2011 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner by Canterbury Park. Nominations closed Thursday, August 25 with 53. (S)

NOMOREWINEFOREDDIE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin while never being challenged and drew off in the stretch under steady pressure. BIZET tracked the pace inside, moved to a striking position through the turn, angled out in the stretch and closed willingly to be clearly best of the rest while no threat to the winner. JOST VAN DYKE well back and inside, moved up through the turn, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch and get up for the show. FREEDOM FIRST well placed and outside, looped three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch and passed a tiring rival. RUSTIC ROAD stalked the pace outside and steadily faded. JESTINTIME was no factor.
