STAKES Minnesota Turf Championship S. - Thoroughbred



FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS. Free to nominate, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start, with \$35,000 guaranteed (\$22,250 from Canterbury Park and \$10,000 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund), of which \$21,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 119 lbs; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 at one mile or over in 2011 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 5 lbs; \$10,000 at a mile or over in 2010-2011, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED (On the Scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2010-2011 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner by Canterbury Park. Nominations closed Thursday, August 25 with 52. (If management deems it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.). (S)

Footnotes

TUBBY TIME mid pack and off the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn, bid just outside the leader into the stretch, then drove clear inside the final furlong. MACK'S BLACKHAWK vied for the early lead outside, challenged for and gained a clear lead through the second turn, could not go with the winner the final furlong, stayed on the hold the place safe and be clearly best of the rest. ERV THE BANKER checked into the first turn, moved up to loop rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then ran evenly in the lane and passed a tiring rival to get up for the show. FIRST CAPTAIN tracked the pace well back on the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch and weakened late. ICE ROCKET was no factor. JONI'S JUSTICE set the early pace inside and faded after a half.
