MAGICAL STORM sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, then lasted under brisk handling. TAPINOT well back and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, got up to the leader and hung. WHUDJAGIDDUMON tracked the pace, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and weakened the final sixteenth. SWEEPY BLUFF well back and outside, came widest into the stretch and got up for a share. T J AND COMPANY ran evenly. SHARP ANGLE stalked the pace outside and faded in the lane. LATE NIGHT AFFAIR well placed and outside, was through after a half. HUMMINATUNE was outrun.
