Footnotes

J'NOODLE rated back inside, moved to a striking position through the second turn, angled out slightly to bid just outside the pace setter, then made a steady gain through the lane and edged ahead in the final strides. HELL 'N MAY well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, closed willingly through the lane and missed. MI CIELO CELEB set the pace from between rivals, gained a clear lead off the rail through the second turn, then weakened and was outfinished inside the final sixteenth. STORMIN DONNA tracked the pace off the rail, steadied along through the second turn gaining position, angled out to bid four wide into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. VIA DI ROMA well back and off the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn, angled out, then drifted out into the stretch and ran evenly the final furlong. DESIGNED TO RUN well back and outside, looped rivals four wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch and had a mild gain. WINSOME GAMES mid pack and off the rail, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, then faded the final furlong. SILENT COPY was no factor. MAKING A RACQUET stalked the early pace three wide, lugged out through the first turn and faded. DIAMOND CITY well placed and off the rail, moved up quickly between rivals, kept a striking position to the quarter pole and faltered.
