MORGANS A BLUMIN void of speed and outside, circled the field through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. I'VE HEARD RUMORS well back and inside, moved up through the second turn, steadied for racing room into the stretch, came through inside of rivals, then steadied at the eighth pole, angled out for clear racing room and closed fast to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. G RAE mid pack and between rivals, moved up on the two path through the turn, steadied slightly into the stretch, then bid between rivals and closed well to get up for the show. HOLE IN ONE tracked the early pace inside, angled out through the second to challenge for and gain a short lead, gained a clear lead into the stretch and weakened the final furlong. CANT CATCH JUDY ran evenly. ALL BETS ARE OFF vied for the early lead inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and ran evenly. JODY'S INCLUDED mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, then weakened in the drive. OAK FLAT set the early pace outside, gained a clear lead quickly, then faltered through the lane. MINGO ACE was never involved. LA MALINCHE was a brief factor, outside.
