Non-winners of \$15,000 twice in 2011 allowed 3 lbs.; \$15,000 in 2011, 5 lbs.; \$10,000 in 2010-2011, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). ATTA BOY ROY vied for the early lead inside, gained a short lead through the turn, then gained a clear lead in the stretch and lasted under steady pressure. JUST JEBICAH well placed and outside, moved up on the two path through the turn, bid three wide into the stretch, made a steady gain through the lane and missed in the final strides. DONT MAKE ME MAD well placed and inside, moved to a striking position through the turn, then flattened out. HUMBLE SMARTY set the early pace three wide, could not go with the winner in the stretch, stayed on and weakened the final furlong. RARE SUNSET well back, moved up outside through the turn, drifted in in the lane and passed a tiring rival. MALONE SLAM well back, looped rivals three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and had no rally. INDY N MISSION was a brief factor and was outrun.
