GENTLE AS A BREEZE stalked the pace in the backstretch, made a three wide bid in the upper stretch and kicked clear late. TIGER RUN tracked the top two leaders in the backstretch, edged up to the lead, vied into the late drive and held on to place in late strides. DE BALA off slowly at the start, lacked racing room nearing the far turn, angled out and rallied along the outside in the drove. JOHN GALT settled in early stages and steadily gained position three wide in the deep stretch. FLASHY EM raced between rivals in the drive and lacked a final kick to make a serious impact. SHARP RICHARD vied for the lead into the stretch, could not keep up the pace and weakened late. SUGAR BUSINESS stalked the pace in early stages and finished evenly. JUST SIR PRIZE ME raced along the inside and lacked a rally. CORPORATE CHARLIE failed to be a threat. RAGGED EDGE raced three wide and was no factor. AFFIRMED CURE failed to menace. FRANZ showed speed along the inside and had nothing left late.
