APPEALS THE DEAL took command at the start, set the pace in the backstretch, continued the leader at the top of the lane, challenged in late drive and held on to prevail. JAIVAL settled in and stalked the pace in early stages, gained position two wide in the deep stretch and just missed in final strides. ERV THE BANKER shifted out four wide at the top of the lane and was along for show. GOLD COUNTRY CAT stalked the pace two wide and lacked a late kick to make an impact. GOOD GUY LARRY saved ground along the rail and was no threat late. PERFECT ABLATION failed to respond. WILLOW PARISH made a bid in the opening quarter and gave way after.
