THATLLEAVEAMARK tracked the pace setter inn the backstretch, edged up to the lead at the top of the lane, vied into the deep stretch, dug in late and prevailed. PAGE MEADOWS set the pace in the backstretch, challenged in the turn, vied into the lane and held on to place in late strides. BIZET settled in early stages, swung out five wide in the far turn and gained position to the wire. SEVEN TUFF reserved in early stages and improved position four wide in the late drive. FREE SAILING made a three wide bid for the leader in the drive and lacked final kick to make impact. GALLERY OF STORMS stalked the pace in the backstretch and failed to respond in the late drive. DELIGHTED DISCIPLE failed to be a factor. SUGAR STORM stalked the pace in the backstretch and lacked response in the drive. HUMAN ERASER raced three wide at the top of the lane and was no menace.
