HI PRIM tracked the pace in the backstretch, split foes in the upper stretch, dug in final furlong and was up at the wire to prevail. FAMILY FOUNDATION dueled along the rail into the lane, continued to battle in the deep stretch and just missed at the wire. FRANKIE DAPPER took command in the opening quarter, challenged and vied with FAMILY FOUNDATION into the deep stretch, just missed in final strides. CHISENAU made a bid along the rail and gained ground to the wire. QUOTE TO CASH angled out at the eighth pole and failed to kick on. CHARGING HOME passed tiring rivals. DESERT PRIZE tracked the pace in the backstretch and came up empty in the drive. T. THOMAS failed to be a threat. PASTERO raced five wide in the first turn and was no factor.

TYMAKER raced four wide into the lane and faded. TRINITY TAVERN stalked the pace in early stages and steadily faded. CHARTER CLASS made a bid in early stages and gave way.
