Footnotes

THUNDERPUMPER, rated in behind rivals early, raced between horses to the far turn, advanced from between foes nearing the final quarter while four wide, reached the front a furlong out and was hard ridden to prevail. SARAVA, allowed to settled followed the leaders four or five wide, followed the winner from the outside into the lane, gained about even terms for the lead at the furlong grounds, then wasn't good enough. POINT PRINCE, bumped at the start, raced within easy striking distance while saving ground, angled out a bit into the upper stretch but couldn't muster the needed response. KASPAROV, well placed from early on while three or four wide between rivals, gained a slim advantage on the second turn, held on well until the final furlong and faltered. WAGONEER, outrun into the stretch, offered a minor gain while unable to menace. CASTNER worked his way inward early to track the dueling leaders four wide, remained close up until nearing the stretch and weakened. GOLD DOLLAR settled in behind horses for six furlongs, came out seven or eight wide for the drive but was empty the last eighth. L X EXPRESS went up soon after the start to contest the pace outside of BAG OF MISCHIEF, raced forwardly for five furlongs and tired. HIGHLAND THUNDER drifted out at the start bumping POINT PRINCE, was outrun for six furlongs, came out nine or 10 wide for the drive and couldn't menace. BAG OF MISCHIEF gained a slim lead early, edged inward, dueled with L X ESPRESS, held on well for six furlongs and weakened thereafter.
