SKY TERRACE, away in good order to force the pace, reached the front just before going a quarter, edged clear approaching the end of the backstretch, showed the way around the turn and into the stretch while three wide, then was under steady right-handed whipping in the drive to prevail. CASHEL CASTLE stalked the leaders from early on while three or four wide, fell back slightly approaching the stretch, angled outside of the winner and IDE BE SPENCERS to race five wide into the lane, then, under stout left-handed encouragement, came again to earn second. IDE BE SPENCERS came out at the break and bumped REVOLVER, was never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, made a menacing run outside of SKY TERRACE approaching the stretch, was just off that one approaching the final furlong, then came up empty after the rider dropped his whip leaving the furlong grounds. CLERGY broke a step slow to trail briefly, was sent up to gain a position near the inside, raced in behind the leaders while creeping closer on the turn, advanced five wide at the quarter-mile ground, then flattened out when straightened for the drive. REVOLVER bobbled sharply at the start, was bumped soon after by IDE BE SPENCERS, raced well off the inside for three furlongs, edged in approaching the end of the backstretch, was outrun until the stretch and unable to menace while coming well off the rail again. GOVERNOR HICKEL moved up along the inside to gain a slim lead early, lost the advantage to CASHEL CASTLE just prior to going a quarter, continued forwardly for a half and faded steadily thereafter.
