## **Footnotes**

DANCING WITH ME, never far back while tracking the pace under light rating four or five wide, moved steadily to challenge approaching the final quarter, stuck a head in front nearing the furlong pole, then proved gamely best under strong handling. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE, always well placed, moved with the winner while inside that one three wide nearing the stretch, gained a slight edge just prior to going six furlongs, was headed by the winner at the furlong grounds and held on stubbornly the remainder. HEY RITA, within easy striking distance while following the leaders four or five wide, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but came up empty. EVIL EYE ALY, nicely placed in behind the leaders from the outset, raced three wide most of the way and lacked a closing account. FEELING SO PRETTY, outrun to the stretch, moved five wide while advancing, angled in a bit between foes in the final furlong, improved position but wasn't a threat. SERMON failed to threaten and was six wide in the stretch run. KIRI'S PRINCESS wasn't a factor. MINEY'S AWESOME broke sharply to gain a brief lead, surrendered it to WHATTACAPOTE, raced forwardly for five furlongs and tired. STAR OF SAVANNAH was never close and eight wide in the drive. WHATTACAPOTE gained the lead inside early, moved clear, widened on the backstretch, surrendered the advantage on the far turn, bobbled and was checked about the five-sixteenths pole, gave way and was eased late..
