Footnotes

MADAM ROCHAS drifted out while breaking alertly, recovered, edged in to track the leaders, raced four wide into the stretch and wore down BALLADO MELODY under strong handling. BALLADO MELODY went up early to press front-running GREENSTORMACOMING, gained a slight edge in the upper stretch, then couldn't contain the winner late UNCOMMON QUEEN settled near the inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out five wide about the sixteenth pole and offered a slight gain. GREENSTORMACOMING moved to the fore early, made the pace into the stretch and weakened. LIGHTNING SPEED, within striking distance always while following the leaders five or six wide, was empty the last eighth. OPULENT eased off the inside, raced between foes three or four wide on the turn and weakened in the drive. OLD FASHION sluggish to start and outrun till the stretch, passed tired foes. STOP THE MEETING was outrun, as was SHOES N' NAILS. SHEZA WILD THING faded after a half.
