JARAMAR RAIN settled early, saved ground in hand, continued in behind the leaders into the stretch, angled out suddenly approaching the eighth pole, put a head in front just after the call, then, despite solid left-handed urging, drifted in and exchanged bumps approaching the wire with WHILETHEIRON'SHOT when that one came out slightly under left-handed pressure. WHILETHEIRON'SHOT gained the lead early, went along under careful handling, was headed briefly on the far turn from the outside by STRIKES NO SPARES, regained the advantage, then held on stubbornly the remainder while coming out nearing the wire and exchanging bumps with the winner. STRIKES NO SPARES, close up from the beginning, eased outside of pacesetting WHILETHEIRON'SHOT to force the issue on the backstretch, put a head in front briefly on the second turn, lost the edge back to that one, then weakened in the drive. SERMON, in contention while tracking the leaders from early on four wide, came out a bit farther on the track for the drive but was empty the last eighth. SARATOGA CAT, unhurried for six furlongs while near the inside, angled out six wide when straightened for the drive but was empty. LASSIE'S LEGACY tired after six furlongs, as did JUST KISS ME QUICK.
