WIN GRAMMY BOY was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance from five wide, continued on well under stern urging through the stretch, caught the leaders with a sixteenth to run and edged clear late. FIFTYCENTSONDOLLAR vied for the lead along the inside, kept on willingly through a long drive but was no match for the winner in the final yards. AZTEC KING prompted the pace three deep, forged a brief lead nearing the eighth pole, but weakened from between horses during the drive and gave way. ARCHIE TRUCKER disputed the pace from between horses to the deep stretch and faded. SATYRS attended the pace off of the inside, came five wide to make a mild bid, angled to the inside with a furlong to run but lacked a response when called upon. OLD SOUTH settled in the second flight and failed to respond. UNETHICAL broke a step slow, settled saving ground but was never a factor.
