Footnotes

VALTRUS settled saving ground early, shifted to the outside on the backstretch, launched his bid with three furlongs to run, came four wide and wore down FAITHOPE in the final yards. FAITHOPE stalked the pace removed from the inside, came four wide to make his move, forged command with a furlong to run, continued on well but settled for the place. CROWNED GENERAL opened clear to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch, drifted in a bit in the drive and grudgingly gave in. VEILED PROPHET was taken in hand at once, angled in to save ground, got through entering the stretch to make his bid, steadied near the furlong marker when CROWNED GENERAL came in and lost his best chance. BROAD RIVER was forwardly placed three wide to the stretch, but faltered from between horses in the drive and faded. HOLD'EM TIGER failed to respond.
