BOB CAN'T JUMP prompted the pace three wide, forged command nearing the furlong marker and edged clear. DOUBLE RAH RAH set the pressured pace along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but kept on well to clearly prove second best. KING ARCHIBALD was allowed to settle three deep, angled to the inside entering the stretch, finished well and was along in time to earn the show. EASY STRIKE contended along the inside, shifted out entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MATTY'S AVENGER settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and improved position. QUEEN'S ESCORT chased four wide to the stretch and faded. STRAWBERRY AMOUR broke slow, moved up between horses, but came up empty leaving the turn and faded. CHEERS AND BEERS showed little. THISBIRDCANDANCE was hustled along off of the inside for a half and dropped out.
