Footnotes

TIBAN tracked the pace four wide, made a sweeping move through the turn, assumed command with a quarter to run, opened clear and held sway. HOME OF THE GOLD was allowed to settle, split rivals to commence his bid, angled out and kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. HONOR IN PEACE vied off of the inside, was caught in tight and was shuffled back near the three-eighths pole, shifted out came four wide but went evenly through the drive. FOREST COAST disputed the pace between horses to the stretch and faded. WIN TUCKER broke slow, was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. GETALONG was allowed to settle, drifted out through the turn and was never a factor. WHY STILLY WHY showed little. AEROMON jammed through along the inside to make a mild bid, but came up empty midway through the turn and retreated.
