SAPPHIRE N' SILK sprinted clear leaving the chute, gained the rail near the five furlong marker, set the pace under confident handling and stayed clear under a steady hand ride. ENGLISH BAY, outrun early off the inside, came out three wide approaching the stretch, moved out a bit farther in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. GRAND DEED, within striking distance off the inside, angled out four wide entering the stretch when making a mild gain then hung in the final furlong. TOUT CHARMANT, never far back three wide, moved closer with a quarter mile to go but weakened in the drive. MILLION QUESTIONS, never far back off the inside, stayed well to the stretch and tired. SAGE FOX, close up while saving ground, continued well for five furlongs and faded.
