Footnotes

PHILADELPHIA BLUES, lightly rated early while following the leaders five wide, continued from that position on the track to advance on the second turn, took over, then was under steady left-handed whipping to edge clear late. BARNEY'S MISTRESS, never far back, went up between foes on the second turn to contest the issue, held on well into the final furlong but wasn't good enough. FESTIVE LADY, reserved inside soon after the start, saved ground for six furlongs, swung out six wide entering the stretch, reached easy striking distance at the eighth pole but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. TRICKY ELAINE went up early to press front-running PRAIRIE PREACHER, drew upon even terms for the lead in the upper stretch but was empty the final furlong. PRAIRIE PREACHER gained the lead early, edged inside, made the pace to the far turn and weakened gradually. PRINCESS PALEFACE saved ground but failed to threaten. SURF CLUB, unruly behind the gate, tired early and gave way.
