Footnotes

ROSE CREEK bobbed soon after the start, settled in behind the dueling leaders, saved ground into the stretch, angled out three or four wide at the furlong grounds and was under left-handed urging to prevail. BUFFALO BOB moved inside early, saved ground to the far turn, came out five wide at the five-sixteenths pole to advance, was with the winner while outside that one in the final furlong and wasn't good enough. TWO POINT TWO MILL, bumped at the start and forced in, was steadied and outrun for six furlongs, came out eight or nine wide for the drive and finished well. CONSCIENCE CLEAR gained the lead inside early, showed the way into the stretch, shook off WAYBIL but could not last. DAKOTA PROSPECT, never far back and saving ground until the stretch, angled out for the drive but was empty late. COPPER TRICK, bumped at the start and checked, was outrun until the stretch and not a threat while improving position. KOLINOR, lightly rated while following the leaders four or five wide edged up on the second turn but flattened out when straightened for the drive. DISTORTED POWER, sluggish to begin and outrun until the stretch, circled foes nine or 10 wide but couldn't menace. MT. BLAKE swerved in at the start jolting TWO POINT TWO MILL, then tired early. WAYBIL pressed front-running CONSCIENCE CLEAR until the stretch and tired.
