### Footnotes

POWERFUL TOUCH settled behind rivals near the inside early, went along under patient handling, moved three wide to take over in the upper stretch and was kept to his task. STRIVE, outrun until approaching the stretch, split rivals four wide nearing the final furlong and outgamed EL RULLER for second. EL RULLER, within easy striking distance while in behind horses to the lane, came out from between horses five or six wide into the final furlong, reached closest attendance to the winner but lacked a final account BIG NUMBERS, outrun to the turn while in behind horses, came out to make a sweeping bid eight wide at the quarter-mile ground, loomed prominently for the last eighth but came up empty. QUEM SE ATREVE (BRZ) vied for the lead near the inside from early on, gained a slight edge, was headed before going a half briefly from the rail by PERFECT CUT, regained the advantage, held on well until the stretch and weakened. CROWNED DANCER, in front after the break while dueling with QUEM SE ATREVE (BRZ), lost the edge to that one, battled close up to the lane and tired. SCRIMSHAW tracked the dueling leaders from the outset while four or five wide, was asked for his best three furlongs out but faltered when straightened for the drive. PERFECT CUT lunged while breaking sluggishly, was never far back, moved up inside to force the pace, reached the front briefly before going a half but weakened soon after. PLAY IT OUT tired after a half.
