CLEAR THE WAY, in hand early while maneuvering in four or five wide to track the leaders, inched to the front nearing the stretch, then was ridden hard in the drive to expand his advantage. HE'S A PIONEER, bumped at the start by CORRYVILLE and forced in, was steadied, quickly settled, made a menacing run four wide nearing the lane, was with the winner while outside that one and couldn't match strides as second best. LOUIE ES bumped from both sides at the start and steadied, was outrun to the stretch, advanced between foes four wide and finished willingly. JIMMY JAMMER, nicely positioned five wide into the upper stretch, was empty when the test came. DEVILOFARUSH, off slow and steadied when shut off, was outrun five wide to the stretch, came wider for the drive and flattened out at the end. MOTCOMBE STREET, outrun for six furlongs while saving ground, circled foes eight wide and improved position. PIANO BUCKS came out at the start bumping LOUIE ES and failed to rally in an even trip. READILY swerved in after the start bumping RAYWICK, forced that one in on CORRYVILLE, raced outside rivals, made a run five wide nearing the final quarter but flattened out in the drive. RAYWICK stumbled at the

start, was forced in to bump CORRYVILLE, angled in to tracked the pace and tired on the turn. CORRYVILLE, bumped at the start by RAYWICK and forced in on HE'S A PIONEER, worked his way near the inside while gaining the lead, made the pace for five furlongs and weakened gradually thereafter. RAGGEDY MAN, well placed inside for five furlongs, weakened thereafter. RES IPSA hopped at the start, gained a forward position inside before going a quarter but was finished midway on the turn.
