Footnotes

ALMOST INNOCENT (IRE), under light restraint while tracking the leaders four wide from the beginning, was patiently handled to the stretch, moved to challenge leaving the eighth pole, took over a sixteenth out and was under urging the remainder. AIMER went up to press front-running ESPLANADE in hand early while three wide, inched to the front before going seven furlongs, then couldn't handle the winner late. MOON MAVEN, well placed three or four wide to the stretch, moved a bit wider for the drive and was slowly gaining at the end. DYNAMIST, forwardly placed from the start while inside under rating, eased out between foes three wide when straightened for the drive, loomed prominently in deep stretch when gaining even terms for the lead but failed to sustain the needed momentum. ESPLANADE gained the lead at the start, maneuvered nicely to the inside, made the pace until nearing the final quarter and weakened. LEGISLADY settled between horses three or four wide early, eased out six wide for the drive but failed to fire. MORLANA worked way inside, continued from the rail on the far turn, angled four wide at the quarter-mile ground but lacked a late account. SOUL SEARCH, four or five wide throughout, never menaced. SIBERIAN AMUR stumbled at the start and never was prominent. PREDATORY LENDER was outrun.
