MEROM made a sweeping move four wide through the turn, took over nearing the five-sixteenths pole and steadily drew away. SPEEDBOAT SALLY moved with the winner five wide through the turn, was unable to match strides with MEROM then was all out to just hold the place. DEVILISH SILVER was hustled along off of the inside, angled out leaving the turn to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. WHITE LAMB opened clear to set the early pace, was unable to match strides with the winner, stayed on to the final furlong and faded. LADY SYMPHONY broke slowly and was away well behind her field, angled in sharply to save ground, closed the gap through the turn, angled out in the upper stretch but flattened out late. DRY WITH A

TWIST settled saving ground, got through to make a mild gain but failed to threaten. STRONG WILLED LADY was hung wide throughout and passed only the tiring ones. CHROMATIC was allowed to settle, came six wide but lacked a response when called upon. BLOWN was fractious in the gate, contended between horses to the stretch and faded. OUR ANGEL STORME was forwardly placed off of the inside for a half and retreated. MISS N. V. was outrun.
