Footnotes

PLEASANT PURSUIT, unhurried for a half, edged up inside on the turn, came out five or six wide for the drive, gained command and was kept to her task. TUCKALUCKY LADY, well placed inside from the start, saved ground into the stretch, split foes three or four wide nearing the final furlong and earned the place. SHESAGAMER, outrun for six furlongs, made a run to reach the leaders a furlong out but failed to continue. PLAY NOT, within striking distance, failed to muster a closing response. MIMICRY, well placed from early on while stalking the dueling leaders four wide, moved boldly from that position to take over approaching the stretch, then flattened out when straightened for the drive. WILD WON bobbled at the start, was outrun until the stretch and 10 wide in the drive. EXCELLENT MINUTE went up early to vie for the lead outside of MILSTURN, battled for the lead until the stretch and tired. SOLITARY RIVER followed the leaders five or six wide but tired upon going five furlongs. MILSTURN moved inside to contest the pace early, held on well until midway of the turn and gave way thereafter.
