Footnotes

SPOKEN FUR, outsprinted early after being bumped at the start by DANCE HALL GIRL, rallied five wide into the stretch, reached the front nearing the sixteenth pole and was hard ridden the remainder to prevail. MEET ME AT MIDNITE, unhurried early, saved ground, rallied from the rail, gained about even terms for the lead in deep stretch and was outfinished. STELLAR drifted out at the start, bumped DANCE HALL GIRL and forced that one out into SPOKEN FUR, went up soon after to vie for the lead outside of PINK SANDALS, gained a slight edged, moved clear into the upper stretch but faltered late. MOLTO VITA , well placed five wide from early on, swerved for a stride at the three-sixteenths pole, remained prominent into deep stretch but came up empty. BEAUTIFUL TREASURE, moved up nicely soon after the start to track the pace three or four wide, loomed prominently between foes for the final furlong but flattened out. MYMICH, outrun and five or six wide on the backstretch, continued in that position while advancing into the stretch, reached contention at the furlong grounds but lacked a further account. DANCE HALL GIRL, bumped at the start by STELLAR and forced out on SPOKEN FUR, was outrun into the stretch, then passed tired rivals seven wide. GAMBLE TO VICTORY, bumped at the start, raced in contention near the inside until the final quarter and weakened thereafter. PULL THE LEVER raced inside and faded upon going a half. PINK SANDALS came out at the start bumping GAMBLE TO VICTORY, moved up inside soon after to battle for the lead, dueled with STELLAR while inside that one until the stretch and weakened. REHEAR broke in front, raced seven or eight wide on the backstretch and faded entering the turn.
