Footnotes

MANHATTAN SKYLINE settled near the inside early, eased out four or five wide on the far turn to edge closer, took over with a sweeping run into the upper stretch, then lasted while steadily drifting out late and brushing with SWEET DEIMOS (GB). The latter broke a step slow, was maneuvered near the inside, save ground until the final quarter, swung out six wide when straightened for the drive, then was floated out and brushed late by the winner as second best. ALIENATED, close up from the start, was eased back outside of STORM DANCER, battled with that one, reached the front briefly between calls nearing the stretch but weakened in the drive. SLAMMIN' LIL, in behind foes three or four wide, raced within easy striking distance but flattened out when the test came. STORM DANCER gained the lead early, edged near the inside, was headed between calls from the outside approaching the stretch by ALIENATED, regained the advantage but faltered in the drive. ALMOST DISSUADED failed to menace. FEMALE ACCOMPLICE settled three wide, was unhurried to the stretch, circled horses eight wide and failed to offer a closing bid. DUSTI'S TUNE, unhurried from the start and four wide most of the way, never rallied. BLU SPUR stalked the dueling leaders from early on while four or five wide, continued close up into the stretch and flattened out.
