BULL MARKET hopped at the break, quickly recovered, angled in to gain a forward position three abreast, inched to the front approaching the final furlong and drove clear. DEPUTY DIRECTOR, outrun for a half, raced in behind rivals, split foes three or four wide in the upper stretch and was second best. WRZESZCZ moved up between foes to contest the issue early, stuck a head in front concluding the turn, held on well until the final furlong and weakened. NIGHTLIFEATBIGBLUE, outsprinted inside early, moved between foes three wide on the turn, came out five wide for the drive but lacked a late account. SELL TO SURVIVE, outrun to the stretch, offered a minor gain while unable to menace. STORM SIZZLE raced inside and was empty in the lane. JET PROSPECTOR drifted out at the break, angled in, stalked the pace four or five wide to the lane and tired. GOLD MINE drifted out at the start and failed to menace. SCRIPTURE gained a slim lead inside early, dueled for a half and tired. PRECIOUS SANDS was outrun.
