Footnotes

SILVER TIMBER within striking distance, advanced three wide late on the turn and closed well to be up in time. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE close up early, steadied once in the turn when BARGE drifted out a bit, recovered, advanced four wide into the stretch and rallied willingly late to be steadily gaining. CENTRAL CITY vied for the lead off the inside, took over with a furlong to go and held on gamely. FORMIDABLE outsprinted early, commenced his rally off the inside on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive and closed well. MORALIST close up along the inside, angled out near the sixteenth marker when rallying and made a late gain. STARFISH BAY alternated for the lead off the inside and tired late. BARGE with the early pace between rivals, dropped back a bit and drifted out with three furlongs to go then weakened. PERFECT OFFICER outrun early, angled out four wide entering the stretch and could not threaten after angling back in a bit. MITIGATION outrun early, came five wide into the stretch and could not menace. HEAVENLY CHORUS was outrun. LIT'SGOODLOOKNGRAY trailed.
