Footnotes

BABU was away alertly, angled in to set the pace, shook clear entering the stretch and held sway under stern urging. ATLANTIC PAWS settled in hand, ranged up three wide, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. BIG FLIRT was unhurried into stride, split horses to make a late rally and was along for the show. SQUANDER tracked the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. DANCING DON was allowed to settle, circled five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. MAJOR ADVANTAGE pulled to the lead five wide, vied for the lead to the stretch, but lugged in through the drive and faded. STRATEGIC DECISION showed little. COOL LION was jostled early and steadied, made a middle move five wide but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out. TAP N POINT was through after a half.
