WILL'S WILDCAT sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace along the inside and drew off under steady handling. THANKFULNESS close up three wide, lodged a mild bid to be second best while no threat to the winner. DEVIL'S HAMMOCK closest to the pace off the inside, made a run at the winner on the second turn but gave way in the drive. HOT RODDER outrun off the inside, improved his position while no threat. DR. HUDSON within striking distance along the inside, gave way. BACK ROOM DEAL within reach of the leaders while off the inside, moved to the rail once in the second turn, held on well to the final quarter and faded. MINEPOWER failed to menace three wide. CANFIELD was no factor.
