Footnotes

IRISH EMPEROR reserved early, made a run four wide late on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and proved narrowly best. STEPH'S SONSET alternated for the lead three wide land held on gamely to miss. ELSAROARIN behind the leaders along the inside, rallied willingly on the rail but missed. PRIME SPEED outrun early, advanced inside out of the turn, split rivals near the sixteenth marker and closed well late. MAD AFTERSHOCK within striking distance, made a mild three wide move on the turn but lacked a late bid. BILLY'S BAND broke slowly, was outrun early, raced four wide with a quarter mile to go and made a late gain. DIVA'S DUKE used early, vied for the lead inside rivals, saved ground on the turn and faded in the stretch. IT'S A SIGNER failed to menace. ENDER'S UNIVERSE alternated for the lead between rivals and gave way. CARDINAL RIDGE was no factor.
