Footnotes

SENACHER outrun early, advanced four wide late on the turn, drifted to the rail approaching the furlong marker then closed willingly inside the leader to be up in time. TIME COUNTS set the pace off the inside, responded willingly when challenged by PRIVATE OFFERING entering the stretch, drew clear with a furlong to go but was outfinished. ENSIGN'S SOUL unhurried early, moved to the inside midway through after the winner rallied past then improved her position while no threat. PRIVATE OFFERING reserved early, made a bold five wide move late on the turn, challenged in upper stretch but tired in the final furlong. VEGAS TRIP forwardly placed in the four path, gave way in the stretch. ODDITY ducked in at the start, rushed inside, forced the pace inside the runner up and faded in the drive. CAIPIRINHA bumped at the start, was prominent three wide and faded. MISS DEVILSTONE bumped at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, steadied midway through the turn and faded.
