Footnotes

VALID CITIZEN settled in hand, advanced between horses through the turn, came three wide and proved best following a prolonged drive. BUDDHA CAN DANCE made a sweeping move five wide, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, continued on well but grudgingly gave way. JOE SIX PACK settled between horses, steadied from tight quarters with five-sixteenths to run, angled out entering the stretch and finished willingly once clear. CHILLINESS was unhurried into stride, settled saving ground, swung six wide leaving the turn and was making up ground late. LUCKY SASS vied for the lead four wide,

opened clear leaving the turn, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. TEETEE'S TAPIT was pinched back at the start and unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. TEEBERRY broke awkwardly, settled saving ground, steadied with three furlongs to run and again near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten thereafter. PATTI'S KITTEN failed to respond. FLATTER ME BLUE contested the pace between horses for a half and retreated. YOUNG JOE disputed the pace along the inside, checked near the five-sixteenths pole and dropped out. TURNTWO pressed the pace between rivals three wide through the turn and stopped.
